The authors are kindly asked to yield copyright to the University of Turku. A copy of the copyright agreement form can be seen on the next page.

Authors and editors are all expected to follow the guidelines regarding publishing and behaviour ethics (such as those listed here <http://publicationethics.org>).

*FJRS* is encouraging transparency and clarity in presenting the results, the background work, the methods, and the bibliography. Inaccurately backed up statements and insufficient referencing result in return of the article to be reworked.

Appropriate consents, permissions and releases are to be obtained if an author wishes to include case studies or other personal information or images of patients or volunteers.

Authors are responsible for obtaining permission to reproduce any material in which they do not own copyright, to be used in both print and electronic media, and for ensuring that the appropriate acknowledgements are included in their manuscript.

Plagiarism is not accepted. Articles submitted should be the result of the author's own research and the parts taken from other authors should be properly acknowledged. Quotations and paraphrases should be clearly indicated.

Authors, co-authors and contributors should be clearly listed at the time of submission. Moreover, conflicts of interest of any kind should be disclosed.

Any request to add, delete or rearrange author names in the authorship of accepted manuscripts must be made before the accepted manuscript is published. Such requests should be sent by the corresponding author to the editor-in-chief and must include the reason for the request and a written confirmation from all authors that they agree with the addition, removal or rearrangement. The publication of the accepted manuscript will be suspended until authorship has been agreed between all involved parties.

Throughout the process of paper evaluation and publication, all communication is made only through corresponding authors.
